Notice is hereby given pursuant to V.T.C.A. Government Code, Chapter 551, that the Board of Directors of Big Oaks Municipal Utility District will meet in regular session, open to the public, on **Wednesday, June 11, 2014 at 12:00 p.m., at offices of Coats|Rose, 3 E. Greenway Plaza, Suite 2000, Texas, a designated meeting place outside the boundaries of the District**, to consider and act upon the following matters:

1. Receive comments from the public;
2. Consider approving minutes of regular meeting held on May 14, 2014;
3. Approve bookkeeper's report, including:
 - (a) Authorize payment of bills;
4. Approve tax collector's report, including:
 - (a) Authorize payments from tax account;
 - (b) Discuss delinquent accounts, consider taking action to terminate service to delinquent tax payers;
5. Receive Operator's report, including:
 - (a) Status of various repair projects; and
 - (b) Authorize operator to terminate service to delinquent accounts;
6. Hear report from Champions Hydro-Lawn, Inc., including:
 - (a) consider proposal to treat drainage channels with herbicide or de-silt drainage channels
7. Receive engineer's report, including:
 - (a) Discuss and approve pay applications and change orders, as necessary;
 - (b) Authorize engineer to prepare plans and specifications, and to advertise projects for bid if necessary;
 - (c) Discuss proposal for Phase II of Jogging Trail and consider acting thereon;
 - (d) Discuss overlook structure for pond and consider taking action thereon;
 - (e) Consider and approve award of contracts; and
8. Hear Attorney's report and consider taking any action requested by Attorney, including:
 - (a) Discuss request to purchase protective vests for constables; and
 - (b) Discuss District website.
9. Such other matters as may come before the Board.


